The two mega-contracts, the Rafale in India and the submarines in Australia, account for more than three-quarters of this amount.

Deliveries down slightly, orders up sharply. The period 2012-2016 will have been marked for France by a 5% drop in its arms exports, according to the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (Sipri), while orders have almost doubled. They should be close to 60 billion euros...
