[Global military spending is set to rise again in 2015](#). They have increased after four years of decline, according to a report published [Tuesday by the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute \(Sipri\)](#).

These expenditures amounted to 1.676 billion dollars, an increase of 1% over one year. The United States, China and Saudi Arabia spent the most, with France representing the seventh budget.
